As the deputy, he is responsible for leading the command's staff activities and managing more than 6,000 military, Department of the Army civilians, and Foreign Local National personnel worldwide.

ACC, a subordinate command of U.S. Army Materiel Command, is comprised of two subordinate commands—the U.S. Army Mission and Installation Contracting Command and the U.S. Army Expeditionary Contracting Command—and six major contracting centers. ACC provides global contracting support to warfighters engaged in military operations, weapon system acquisition, life cycle management and sustainment and acquisition of goods and services vital to the Soldier's mission and well-being. Its workforce includes more than 6,000 military and civilian personnel at more than 100 locations worldwide. ACC awarded and managed more than 173,000 contract actions valued at more than \$54 billion in fiscal year 2015.



He previously served as ECC Executive Director; Army Contracting Command Director of Contracting Operations, Chief of the Office of the Principal Assistant Responsible for Contracting at ACC-Aberdeen Proving Ground, MD; PARC, U.S. Army Intelligence and Security Command, Fort Belvoir, VA; and Director of Contracting, Aberdeen Proving Ground. A retired Army Quartermaster and Acquisition Corps officer, Mr. Samson held numerous command and staff positions during his more than 20-year career. After retiring from the military, he served as City Manager in his hometown of Horseheads, located in the Finger Lakes region of upstate New York.
