



U.S. Army Contracting Command **Command Sergeant Major Jose A. Castillo**

Command Sgt. Maj. Jose A. Castillo is the fourth Command Sergeant Major for the U.S. Army Contracting Command. Command Sgt. Maj. Castillo serves as the ACC Commanding General's senior enlisted adviser on all enlisted matters, particularly in areas affecting Soldier training and quality of life. He assumed the position April 19, 2016.



ACC, a subordinate command of U.S. Army Materiel Command, is comprised of two subordinate commands—the U.S. Army Mission and Installation Contracting Command and the U.S. Army Expeditionary Contracting Command—and six major contracting centers. ACC provides global contracting support to warfighters engaged in military operations, weapon system acquisition, life cycle management and sustainment and acquisition of goods and services vital to the Soldier's mission and well-being. Its workforce includes more than 6,000 military and civilian personnel at more than 100 locations worldwide. In fiscal year 2015, ACC awarded and managed more than 173,000 contract actions valued at more than \$54.7 billion.

Command Sgt. Maj. Prior to joining ACC, CSM Castillo was Command Sergeant Major for the 19th Expeditionary Sustainment Command.

He has served in every enlisted leadership position ranging from Team Leader to Command Sergeant Major in the 82nd Airborne Division. He has completed numerous combat tours in support of Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom. He has led units in combat as a Task Force CSM, Brigade Support Battalion CSM, and Brigade CSM.

His military and civilian education includes: U. S. Army Airborne School; Jump Master Course; Air Assault Course; Primary, Basic and Advanced Noncommissioned Officer's Course; Battle Staff; United States Army Sergeants Major Academy, Command Sergeants Major Course. He also has a bachelor's degree from Excelsior College, Albany, NY.

CSM Castillo's awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit with one Oak Leaf Cluster; Bronze Star with two Oak Leaf Clusters; Defense Meritorious Service Medal; Meritorious Service Medal with three Oak Leaf Clusters; Army Commendation Medal with three Oak Leaf Clusters; Army Achievement Medal with one Oak Leaf Cluster; Military Outstanding Volunteer Service Medal; NATO Medal; Master Parachutist Badge; Air Assault Badge and Australian, British and German Parachutist Badges.
