Topic	Question or Comment	Answers
Accommodations	Please use entire room next time and increase space between chairs. Very uncomfortable for all.	We will consider this.
BOA 6 Release	When will the team changes submitted by current BOA Holders in March 2015 be incorporated into the BOA? Due to the delay in BOA RFP #6, will BOA holders be able to propose new team members in upcoming task order solicitations if the modified BOAs are not yet executed?	The modifications will be complete at the same time as execution of BOA 6. BOA Holders will not be able to propose new team members until the modification which incorporates the updated Attachment 0002 is signed; however, RFPs for requirements originally synopsized as part of BOA6 will not issued until BOA6 is executed .
EAGLE Master Schedule	During a past BOA Holder's Meeting the Government announce the Ft Lee RFP was being released that evening. About 10% of the SB reps then left the meeting to tackle their proposals. The Government was questioned about timing/ Scheduling. Today we sit in this room with the Ft. Rucker proposal due in less than 1 week - probably less with a Friday upload. Does the Government recognize the scheduling conflicts and the burden placed on SB?	The Government takes all factors into consideration when establishing the task order competition milestones, including BOA holders meetings and mission requirements. We also seek to minimize travel events by synchronizing the Spring BOA Holders meeting with the annual APBI.
EAGLE Performance	Can you discuss the performance of: Eagle - How many Satisfactory CPARS? How many CAR Notices? How many Cure Notices? Satisfactory surveys from the DOLs?	The Government is continuously tracking the performance of the EAGLE Task Orders and evaluating any issues for required changes to the PWS for future competitions.
Exempt Salaries	What happens if the proposed exempt salaries (based on wage surveys) are significantly lower than the incumbent exempt salaries? Will the Government consider an equitable adjustment to account for this?	We have recently added the following language to our EAGLE task order awards: The direct labor rates contained in this contract (to include those included by way of incorporation of the contractor's proposal) are considered binding to the extent described herein. The contractor shall inform the contracting officer of any change in its direct labor rates prior to submitting an invoice containing direct labor rates other than those agreed to previously. If new direct labor rates are proposed, the Contracting Officer shall make a determination as to the reasonableness of the submitted direct labor rate(s). If determined reasonable, the contractor shall be authorized to pay and invoice at those newly agreed upon direct labor rates.
Past Performance	Why evaluate PP beyond Acceptable/Unacceptable as these are LPTA? No value beyond identification of poor performance?	The majority of the EAGLE Task Order RFPs are a best value source selection process which includes the evaluation of the following factors (1) Technical, (2) Past Performance, (3) Cost/Price, and (4) Small Business Utilization (potentially). The Government will make an award to the responsible Offeror (in accordance with FAR 9.1) whose proposal complies with the RFP requirements and is determined to be the lowest total evaluated (fair and reasonable) priced proposal that is determined to be Technically Acceptable with Substantial Confidence in past performance.
Past Performance	How does ACC determine if Past Performance is relevant? Is the analysis performed at the Functional Area level (i.e. Maintenance, Supply and Transportation), or does the analysis go into the subcategories for each Functional Area?	Relevancy is determined by reviewing recent contracts which provide services in any of the three functional areas of Maintenance, Supply and/or Transportation services, representative missions, maintenance of equipment, or management of classes of supply as outlined in the Basic Ordering Agreement (BOA) Holder's BOA Performance Work Statement (PWS). Analysis is performed at the Functional Area level.
Past Performance	What is the definition of a "performance problem"? Is it tied to specific formal USG document or rating?	A contract is considered to have "performance problems" when a CAR or Cure notice has been issued for this contract action or when a specific area is rated at Marginal or below in CPARS.
Past Performance Scope	If an Offeror intends to perform all scope in one Functional Area, are the \$\$ thresholds for that Task Order (minimum annual amount for Maintenance, Supply, and Transportation) assessed based on one contract reference or will multiple contracts with performance in the same year be combined to determine whether an Offeror's performance meets the threshold for that Functional Area?	Magnitude determinations are made on a single contract basis.
Past Performance Scope	If an Offeror submits a proposal that has them sharing scope with a teammate / major subcontractor / or subcontractor under one Functional Area, are the \$\$ values of past performance of both the Offeror and teammate / major subcontractor / or subcontractor combined to determine whether the offer meets the \$\$ threshold for that Functional Area?	Dollar amounts are not combined, each teammate is reviewed separately.
Past Performance Updates	Many of the PP references we were required to update, both as a prime and our subs, were out of the recency range. Why were these PPs even on the schedule to update? Time and other resources were spent on research.	Recency dates were included so BOA Holders could validate the Period of Performance date. In future data calls only recent references will be provided.

Range of Offers

The range discussion was very good. One change that was not discussed that would be helpful would be the disclosure of the range of offers who were in the original and final competitive range. That allows all of us to know where we fell in relationship to the range (whether in or out).
