Is it correct to assume that all subcontractors, regardless of the size of their scope of work, are to be identified in this section of the Offeror's proposal and the organizational diagram?	The word "Major" was only in the draft RFP and not in the final Solicitation issued. IAW L.5.2.1.3(b)(1) your assumption is correct.
134	RFP for EAS/APS-2 (W52P1J15R0195)	Please confirm that as with previous EAGLE RFPs the Government defines labor brokers as vendors and not teammates/subcontractors, regardless of the total contract dollars.	This RFP stands alone, and only in Attachment 0005 were Labor Brokers defined for the purpose of submitting Attachment 0005.
135	RFP paragraphs L.5.4.2.6.1(a) and L.5.4.2.6.1(b)	Are labor brokers distinguished separately from Teammates/Subcontractors for purposes of L.5.4.2.6.1(a) and L.5.4.2.6.1(b)? If yes, please explain.	No, the only time labor brokers are defined is in Attachment 0005. Labor brokers are considered Teammates/Subcontractors in reference to Sections L and M.
136	RFP sections L.5.4.2.9(a) and L.5.4.2.10	Please confirm that the two files "Offeror's_Name_Vol_4_DLRD_Applicable_Year(s)" and "Offeror's_Name_Vol_4_IERD_Applicable_Year(s)" are not required from a Subcontractor who will support the Offeror under a fixed-price hourly labor rate type contract.	IAW L.5.4.2.9, L.5.4.2.9(a)(1), L.5.4.2.10(a), L.5.4.2.10(a)(2), L.5.4.2.10(a)(3), L.5.4.2.10(b)(1)(i), L.5.4.2.10(b)(1)(ii), L.5.4.2.10(b)(2) and L.5.4.2.10(b)(2)(i) the two files are required if a Teammate/Subcontractor is submitting an independent Cost/Price proposal, regardless of the contract type.
137	L.5.2.1.2(b), L.5.2.1.3(a)(3)(i)	Will the Government accept as part of Volumes I and IV a cover page which includes the Offerors restricted data notice which ensures no proprietary information can be released? As shown in the reference noted above, offeror page count in Vol 2 excludes cover page.	<p>The Government acknowledges the need to ensure proprietary data is protected; as such many of the submissions required for Volume I and Volume IV have no page limit and allows for a cover page to not be counted in the page limitation. This type of statement could be included as part of the cover page.</p> <p>Volume 1 has no page limitations IAW L.5.1.1(c), L.5.1.2(c), L.5.1.3(c), L.5.1.4(c), L.5.1.5(c), L.5.1.6(e), L.5.1.7.1(c), L.5.1.7.2(c), and L.5.1.7.3(c).</p> <p>Volume 2 does have page limitations IAW L.5.2.1.1(a)(3), L.5.2.1.2(a)(3), and L.5.2.1.3(a)(3). However, IAW L.5.2.1.1(a)(3)(i), L.5.2.1.2(a)(3)(i), and L.5.2.1.3(a)(3)(i) it states, "Page limit excludes cover page, table of contents, and glossary of abbreviations and acronyms."</p> <p>Volume 4 has no page limitations IAW L.5.1.8(e), L.5.4.1.1(b)(3), L.5.4.2.1(c), L.5.4.2.2.1(c), L.5.4.2.3(c), L.5.4.2.4(c), L.5.4.2.5.1(d), L.5.4.2.6.1(c)(3), L.5.4.2.7.1(c), L.5.4.2.9(d), and L.5.4.2.10(f).</p>
