W52P1J-14-R-0060, page 36, L.2.2.3 (JV information)	Does the Managing Partner of a newly established JV have to have past performance, or can the JV solely rely on the other partner's PP?	<p>Offerors can submit any references they deem applicable to their proposal. L.4.1.2.2 states that at a minimum, the references for the Offeror and proposed teammates in Attachment 0002 (TAB 2) shall be included in Attachment 0006 - (TAB 1).</p> <p>Therefore, if any member of your JV is providing similar experience, they must also provide a past performance reference. M.2.3.2 The Offeror will be assessed individually and/or collectively (in the case of teammates and joint venture partners) and the results will then be assessed in their totality to determine the Offerors Past Performance Evaluation Rating of Acceptable or Unacceptable. M.2.3.3 (b) The Government may use information obtained from other available sources; this may include relevant databases or known information about performance under recent/relevant contracts whether or not those contracts are disclosed to the Government by the Offeror, including but not limited to, speaking with other Government agencies regarding past performance.</p>
W52P1J-14-R-0060, page 38 L.3.1.2.2.1 (d). These Attachment 0002 Section I instructions state that Lines 4 through 32 shall identify the Offeror's name or the proposed Teammate that demonstrates the organizational capability.	Do we list the JV (Offerors) name under Column E of Attachment 0002 Section I or the individual JV Company that is the prime/sub of the actual contract number that will appear on Attachment 0002 Section II?	Please see Amendment 0003 for instructions.
Attachment 0002 of W52P1J-14-R-0060, Column C and Column D of Attachment 0002	Column C of Attachment C referenced the PWS Paragraphs 2.1.2; 2.1.16 and 2.1.17. These paragraphs do not exist in the PWS. Column D identified the title for PWS Paragraph 2.1 as "Installation Material Maintenance Activity." However, the actual title in the PWS is "Functional Requirements - Maintenance, Supply, and Transportation Support" Is Attachment 0002 refering to a different PWS. Can you provide us with the PWS which has those paragraphs.	PWS was revised in Amendment 0002 to W52P1J-14-R-0060.
Attachment 0002 of W52P1J-14-R-0060, Column C and Column D of Attachment 0002	All the PWS paragraphs referenced in Column C and all the functional area titles referenced in Column D do not match the paragraph numbers and the titles in the PWS, Attachment 0001 of W52P1J-14-R-0060.	PWS was revised in Amendment 0002 to W52P1J-14-R-0060.
Attachment 0002; Section I - Organizational Capability; Column E - Name/CAGE	The column appears to be locked (i.e., can't wrap text or expand height of column). We can artifically wrap words by inserting information, hitting the enter key, and inserting more information. However, since we can't expand the column height, the full company and CAGE code are not visible to an observer. Please provide an unlocked version of the attachment.	Amendment 0002 revised Attachment 0002 to allow for the formatting of cells in the unlocked columns and rows. NOTE: Typing the information in the Excel document is recommended. In order to copy and paste from a different document you must right click in the cell, Paste Special as TEXT. Once the text is in the Attachment 0002 it can be copied and pasted throughout the entire document as needed. This change also will allow offerors to format the cells.

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Attachment 0001 - PWS; Attachment 0002, Section I and Section II.	Task numbering is inconsistent between the PWS and Attachment 0002. For example, 2.1 in the PWS (page 3) is "Functional Requirements - Maintenance, Supply, and Transportation" but 2.1 in Attachment 0002 is "Installation Material Maintenance Activity". Additionally, task numbering in the PWS appears to be incorrect. For example, 2.2 appears twice - first on page 3 as "Maintenance and Supporting Functions" and then again on page 7 as "Supply". Please provide the correct PWS and/or Attachment 0002.	PWS was revised in Amendment 0002 to W52P1J-14-R-0060.
Attachment 0002, Section I - Organizational Capability and Section II - Similar Experience; Solicitation page 38 of 50, Sections L.3.1.2.2.1 (d) and (e) (Instructions for Attachment 0002, Section I - Organizational Capability Worksheet [Tab 1]), Column E and Sections L.3.1.2.2.3 (a) and (b) (Instructions for Attachment 0002, Section II - Similar Experience [Tab 2], Column E).	The instructions for Attachment 0002, Section I require the insertion of a company name and CAGE code showing experience in Column E, Lines 4 - 51. This includes subtasks (Lines 4 - 32) as well as mission areas (Lines 33 - 37), equipment types (Lines 38 - 42), classes of supply (Lines 43 - 46), and transportation areas managed (Lines 47 - 51). The instructions for Attachment 0002, Section II require a description in bulleted format for similar experience in Lines 4 - 32 of Section I. The instructions do not ask for description in bulleted form for information on Section I, Lines 33 - 51 (mission and types of equipment types, types of supplies, and transportation areas). <u>Question 1</u> - is it correct to assume that all the information required on mission and equipment types, types of supply, and transportation areas is the name/CAGE code in Attachment 0002, Section I and nothing is required in Section 2? <u>Question 2</u> - if this is incorrect, please identify the type of information required and where it is to be provided.	The only information required for Attachment 0002, Section I is the name and CAGE code. Nothing is required in Attachment 0002, Section II.
Solicitation, pg40, L.3.1.2.2.4.1, L.3.1.2.2.6, L.3.1.2.2.7	RFP states more than one contract number can be used (by the same contractor) for a PWS paragraph in attachment 2 tab 2 column F. How ever it doesn't state how to enter multiple periods of performance or place of performance in column H or I. Please clarify how the government wants the data entered into Column H & I in the event of multiple contracts?	The Government does not have a preference as to how the data in Column H & I is submitted for multiple contract references (by the same contractor). What is expected is the submission clearly identifies the reference the data pertains to.
Section L, PWS, Page 37 of 50	In reference to Attachment 0003 Letter of Consent, each team member is to fill one of these out giving the government permission to check their PP. The attachment is to be saved as OfferorName_Att0003_LetterofConsent. Would we replace Offeror with the Team member name? Otherwise we will not be able to save the file for each team member with the same name.	Please submit the letters of consent for each teammate in one file. The offeror name, not the teammate's name should be included in the file title.
