As the prime, must we fill in all of the blocks for those 2 support areas (i.e. maintenance and supply); or</p> <p>2) Can we use team member experience to supplement each support area (mainteannce, supply, and transportation).</p> <p>3) If we can use team member experience to supplement each support area, must we still, as a prime, maintain 51% or a certain percentage of expertise in each support area?</p>	<p>1) In Attachment 0002 Offerors must show organizational capability by entering in column E a YES for the following: all of the subtasks for lines 5-33, a minimum of three subtasks for lines 34-38, a minimum of three subtasks for lines 39-43, a minimum of two subtasks for lines 44-47, and a minimum of three subtasks for lines 48-52.</p> <p>Further, Offerors must demonstrate similar experience by entering in column F their similar experience for the following: all maintenance subtasks for lines 5, 6, 12, 13; all supply subtasks for lines 14, 15, 19, 22; and all transportaion subtasks for lines 23, 26, 27, 29, 32, 33.</p> <p>Offerors must also demonstrate similar experience by entering in column F their similar experience for the following: three or more of the maintenance subtasks for lines 7, 8, 9, 10, 11; three or more of the supply subtasks for lines 16, 17, 18, 20, 21; and three or more of the transportation subtasks for lines 24, 25, 28, 30, 31.</p> <p>2) Refer to section L.1.6 for the definition of an Offeror.</p> <p>3) There is no requirements at Step 2 for a prime maintaining a certain percentage of expertise for each support area. However, Offerors must abide by the clauses/requirements for each of the task orders in Step 3.</p>

Does W52P1J-13-R-0032 allow key personnel experience for contract mission oversight?</p> <p>2) If the answer to the question above is YES: Can Key Personnel experience of a former government employee over contract missions include Directorate level management (e.g. Deputy/Director of Logistics) experience over the Logistic contract missions in addition to Contract Officer Representative (COR) assignment dates?</p> <p>3) L.3.1.1.1 allows for prime or subcontractor with a period of performance with the last five years. Will this also include Key Personnel experience over Government missions (e.g. CIF, Unit Movements or Arrival/Departure Airfield Control Group)?</p>	<p>1) No, key personnel oversight cannot be used for experience.</p> <p>2) N/A</p> <p>3) No, key personnel oversight cannot be used for experience.</p>

3	RFP Requirements	<p>Per this paragraph, offerors are to submit only one Attachment 0002 but may propose up to 10 teammates. When there is an overlap of experience amongst teammates, the cells in Column F and Column O will be quite lengthy. Additionally, this format may make it difficult for the offeror to differentiate and line up which reference pertains to which teammate from column to column.</p> <p>Question: Is it permissible for offerors to detail each teammate's capability in a separate tab (worksheet) within the single Attachment 0002 (workbook)?</p>	<p>As stated in L.3.1.2, the offerors must submit only one attachment 0002. We require the offerors detail the teammates capability on one tab in Attachment 0002.</p>
