<p>RFP, Page 71, L.1.5(c)(ii)(1); RFP, Page 77, L.5.2.2.3</p>	<p>For certain functional area requirements, capability may be provided for some but not all of the listed performance areas (example, 3 of 5 types of equipment in maintenance). In this case, if an offeror provides its own capabilities for 3 of 5 types and includes a teammate who provides capabilities for the remaining 2 types, should that teammate be considered an addition teammate or an organizational capacity teammate?</p>	<p>IAW RFP, paragraph L.5.2.1, if the offeror can provide the capability to perform all requirements in a functional area without the reliance on any teammate, it should NOT propose a teammate in support of that functional area. In other words, if the offeror can otherwise meet ALL the MINIMUM requirements set forth in the RFP for any functional area (e.g. 3 of 5 types of equipment in maintenance), it should not include any teammates in that functional area. IAW M.2.2.4.1(a), the " offeror will be found self-reliant for a specific functional area if, in its Organizational Capability Narrative, it relies upon only its organic relevant experience for that functional area."</p> <p>If reliance on other teammates is required to meet other MINIMUM requirements set forth in the functional area, then any teammate(s) providing a capability over and above the minimum should be considered an addition teammate. IAW L.5.3.3.1 addition teammates are not identified in the offeror's organizational capability. Instructions for proposing addition teammates is found at L.5.3.3.3.</p>

Solicitation, Page 75, Para L.4.1.1	Para L.4.1.1 states: For all documents, each page shall include the complete offeror's name, offeror's CAGE Code, BOA RFP number, and proposal submission date in a header and/or footer. Question: Are we suppose to add this information in the header and/or footer for Attachment 0003, 0004, 0005, 0006, Section I Clauses, Section K Clauses, SF30(Amendments), and SF33?	All documents that are to be submitted require a header and/or footer with with offeror's name, offeror's CAGE Code, BOA RFP number, and proposal submission date.
Solicitation, Page 76, Para L.5.2.2 (c) (6)	What is the smallest allowable font size for a table?	Per L.5.2.2(c)(6), for charts and diagrams, font size shall be no less than 8 point font.
Organizational Capability Narrative	In the 12 page technical response required for the new BOA solicitation (W52P1J-16-R-0029) could you please clarify what the customer intends by "organizational capability"? With only 12 pages I assume it is not a "how" we are going to perform each task but I am not sure what type of narrative is asked for. Any help is appreciated.	The offeror is required to provide evidence and sufficient detail to substantiate the validity of its performance for each functional area (reference paragraph L.4.1.3). Also reference the RFP, paragraph L.5.2.2.1, where it states that the offeror must provide specific recent and relevant experience for each of the functional area requirements and DESCRIBE in terms of the associated SERVICES SIMILAR to the BOA PWS. The Government does NOT expect the offeror to provide "how" it performed a certain function, the Government requires the offeror to demonstrate what task was performed within a functional area that relates to a contract reference that is provided in Attachment 0004.
