# Mission and Functions

- **Enterprise Migration – Team**
  - HQ MICC Level—Chief, Client Advocates, Procurement Analysts
  - Center Level—Client Advocate at each Center (7 total)
- **Strategic Focus – Improve contract award process efficiency and effectiveness**
  - Devise metrics, tools and management processes
  - Employ client advocates and MICC subject matter experts
  - Establish migration council that sets business process rules
- **Enterprise Migration Program Major Functions**
  - Workload migration/management
  - Milestone tracking/management
  - Support and Training





# Migration Program

## ➤ Migration Council

- MICC Commanding General (CG), PARC, Center Directors, EMPM staff and DOC representatives
- Set business rules/review migration candidates (3 year forecast)
- Start-up with semi-annual meetings, last session 2/09 and next session planned concurrent with MICC DOC conference

## ➤ MICC Migration Council Outcome (2/09)

- Migration council rules/guidance published 3/09
- Reviewed 652 actions (\$50B), approved 223 (\$38B) vs. June 2008 council that reviewed 148 actions (\$8B) and migrated 95 (\$2.3B)
- Aligned DOCs with MICC centers

## ➤ Current Business Rules

- Threshold remained at \$5.5M unless exception or waiver applies
- Excluded one-time construction, commercial supply items (except high visibility), emergency/urgent and Ability One actions





# Support/Path Forward

## ➤ DOC/Center Training

- PARC client advocates built website, developed 20 training modules and secured/posted 50 additional modules
- Acquired expertise and positioned to conduct special training/assistance such as DAU SAWs workshops/Tiger Teams
- Conducted personal assistance visits to resolve issues stalling acquisitions and provide special training (Market Research)

## ➤ Mission Support

- New customer inquiries
- Workload distribution/assessment (BRAC/Joint Basing/Transformation) EOY Strategy/Assignments
- Acquisition forecast and user master contract list

## ➤ Future Focus

- Automate MTR Program (\$60-70K) real-time data
- Use existing 1102 cadre for customer training/assistance
- Align with CG intent for Subordinate Commands





# Milestone Tracking Program

- **Establish metrics/means for assessing/managing MICC contract award efficiency/effectiveness**
  - Research, Center/DOC input identified “Top Ten” milestones
  - Timelines based on type contract/order, value and complexity
  - Provided hands-on Center/DOC training
- **Required on all pre-award actions submitted to PARC or higher for review/approval, including “High Visibility” actions**
  - Substantial program growth from inception June 2008 (80/2B) to December 2009 (170/16B)
  - Assessment/roll-up report submitted monthly
- **Provides a snapshot in time to measure progress**
  - Labor intensive effort obtaining value added/timely input
  - General Officer level customer notices for missed milestones


